

STATEMENT OF FAITH

This statement of faith is a broad evangelical declaration of the concepts considered vital for the gospel. It is required that all students seeking enrollment in New Geneva Theological Seminary be able to concur with this broad statement of doctrine. (This general statement of faith for students should not be understood as overruling the commitment of the institution and its professors to the biblical system of doctrine contained in the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms.) The statement of faith is as follows:

- The Bible is the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.
- There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- Our Lord Jesus Christ is God and man in one person. He was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, performed miracles, and vicariously atoned for sin through His shed blood and death. He was bodily resurrected from the dead. He ascended to the right hand of God the Father and will personally return in power and glory.
- Regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential for the salvation of lost and sinful man.
- God justifies the sinner on the basis of Christ's righteousness which is imputed to him by grace alone and which is received by faith alone.
- Eternal life is received by faith, that is, trusting in Jesus Christ alone for salvation.
- The Holy Spirit indwells all true believers and enables them to live a godly life.
- Both the saved and the lost will be resurrected from the dead; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
- There is spiritual unity of all true believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
